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Week 1: January 3rd – 9th

Prayer Focus and Scripture

Day 1 (Jan 3): Ask God to totally and unconditionally accept me in the beloved. “For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will—to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.” (Eph 1:4-6)

Day 2 (Jan 4): Pray for God to love your family and carry them all their life. “He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young.” (Isa 40:11)

““Listen to me, you descendants of Jacob, all the remnant of the people of Israel you whom I have upheld since your birth, and have carried since you were born. Even to your old age and gray hairs I am he, I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.” (Isa 46:3-4)

Day 3 (Jan 5): Pray that God gives us a heart of Love and not fear. “The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “*Abba, Father.*”” (Rom 8:15)

“For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.” (2 Tim 1:7)

Day 4 (Jan 6): Pray that God keeps His promise to us. “Not one of all the Lord’s good promises to Israel failed; every one was fulfilled.” (Josh 21:45)

““Now I am about to go the way of all the earth. You know with all your heart and soul that not one of all the good promises the Lord your God gave you has failed. Every promise has been fulfilled; not one has failed.” (Josh 23:14)

““Praise be to the Lord, who has given rest to his people Israel just as he promised. Not one word has failed of all the good promises he gave through his servant Moses.” (I Kings 8:56)

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Day 5 (Jan 7): Pray that God will meet all our needs. “Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.” (Matt 6:8)

“The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name’s sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.” (Psalms 23)

“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.” (Phil 4:19)

“Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.” (Prov 3:9-10)

Day 6 (Jan 8): Pray for God to show us His love. “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)

“Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.” (I John 4:8-10)

Day 7 (Jan 9): Pray that God will guard the church as the apple of His eye. “In a desert land he found him, in a barren and howling waste. He shielded him and cared for him; he guarded him as the apple of his eye,” (Deu 32:10)

“Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings” (Ps 17:8)

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Week 2: January 10th – 16th

Prayer Focus and Scripture

Day 8 (Jan 10): Pray for God to continue to fight for GSMBC and that we will win. “The Lord your God, who is going before you, will fight for you, as he did for you in Egypt, before your very eyes, and in the wilderness. There you saw how the Lord your God carried you, as a father carries his son, all the way you went until you reached this place.” (Deut 1:30-31)

“David said to the Philistine, “You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the Lord will deliver you into my hands, and I’ll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds and the wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord’s, and he will give all of you into our hands.” (I Sam 17:45-47)

“Wherever you hear the sound of the trumpet, join us there. Our God will fight for us!” (Neh 4:20)

Day 9 (Jan 11): Pray that the Father will keep my family from evil.

“I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. He will not let your foot slip—he who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. The Lord watches over you—the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.” (Ps 121)

“While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except the one doomed to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.” (John 17:12,15)

“Don’t let anyone deceive you in any way, for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs and the man of lawlessness^[a] is revealed, the man doomed to destruction.” (II Thes 2:3)

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Day10 (Jan 12): Pray that the Father will Love GSMBC with and everlasting love. “The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: “I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.” (Jer 31;3)

Day11 (Jan 13): Pray that the Lord does not remember our sins and iniquities. “For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.” (Heb 8:12)

Day12 (Jan 14): Pray that God gives us a new eagerness to be what He wants us to be so that He can do what He wants to do through us to break, hold, make and conform us to the image of Christ. “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.” (Matt 5:6)

“And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.” (2 Cor 3:18)

Day13 (Jan 15): Pray that God to show is not to limit Him. Pray that we will trust Him, His timing, His methods, and His leadership to work in ways beyond anything we could think or plan. “Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.” (Eph 3:20-21)

Day14 (Jan 16): Pray that each of us will prepare the way of the Lord in our own hearts, the highway of holiness, the way of purification, praise and prayer. “and saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.” This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah: “A voice of one calling in the wilderness, ‘Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.’” (Matt 3:2-3)

“A voice of one calling: “In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain. And the glory of the Lord will be revealed, and all people will see it together. For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.” (Isaiah 40:3-5)

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Week 3: January 17th – January 24th

Prayer Focus and Scripture

Day 15 (Jan 17): Pray that God lets nothing separate us from His love. “Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (Rom 8:35-39)

Day 16 (Jan 18): Pray for God to not remember my sins and iniquities. “For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.” (Heb 8:12)

Day 17 (Jan 19): Pray that nothing can pluck you out of His hand. “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all[a]; no one can snatch them out of my Father’s hand.” (John 10:27-29)

Day 18 (Jan 20): Pray that God helps us walk in peace, and not be anxious or worried about anything. “For God is not a God of disorder but of peace—as in all the congregations of the Lord’s people.” (I Cor 14:33)

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,” (Gal 5:22)

“And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.” (Phil 4:7)

Day 19 (Jan 21): Pray that the Father will redeem our life from all our past. “For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.” (I Peter 1:18-19)

Day 20 (Jan 22): Pray that God revives us when we are weary and exhausted. “He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.” (Isa 40:29)

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Day 21 (Jan 23): Pray that God my Father is my Abba, Papa God. I am His beloved child. “The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “*Abba*, Father.” (Rom 8:15)

“But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship. Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “*Abba*, Father.” So you are no longer a slave, but God’s child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.” (Gal 4:4-7)

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Day 22 (Jan 24): We will conclude our 21 Days of Prayer with a Declaration of Victory in Jesus Christ and a closing prayer of commitment to Him. “for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.” (I John 5:4)

“But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.” (I Cor 15:57)

Declarations of Victory

1. All power is yours, Sovereign God My Father!
2. I have confessed Jesus as my Savior and Lord.
3. I am redeemed by the blood of the Lamb and clothed in His righteousness.
4. I am in Christ. I am co-crucified, co-buried, co-resurrected, co-ascended, and co-seated at the right hand of the Father.
5. The Holy Spirit lives in me, and I receive all His full operation in my life.
6. I yield myself to all of God for His service and His glory.
7. The devil has no place in me, no power, dominion, rule, authority, or force over me. There are no unsettled claims nor effectual assignment against me.
8. All is covered by the spotless blood of the Lamb.
9. I overcome Satan by the victory of the blood of the Lamb.
10. I stand against every lie the deceiver ever told me.
11. I refuse all the devil’s accusations, condemnation, and guilt, having placed all my sins on the cross.
12. I take back all ground I ever gave Satan.
13. I close every door I ever opened to Satan, intentionally or in ignorance.
14. I have perfect liberty and victory in Jesus and live in it, in Jesus’ name.
15. Christ is victorious over all power of the enemy, and I am also in Him.

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Closing Prayer

As your child, Father, I have confessed every known sin, am covered and cleansed by the blood of my Savior. Jesus redeemed me from all the enemy's assignments when He died on the cross. The mighty name of Jesus cancels every curse or evil word. I am released from my sins and the sin of my ancestors. The cross of Jesus stands between them and me. In the name of Jesus, I break all demonic workings that have come against me or my family, past or present.

Father, in the name of Jesus, I choose not to agree with my thoughts or feelings that the enemy has tried to put in my life. You in me is greater than any way that he may try to influence me. I do not have to name all Satan's input because your name is greater than it all. I stand against his assignments. I will not give Satan access in my life by acting or speaking on the basis of lies and deception. They were nailed to the cross. I choose the light, truth, and freedom of Jesus.

I am eternally committed to my Lord Jesus as his bondservant. I have been co-crucified and co-resurrected with Christ, and I now sit with Him at the Father's right hand. I agree with your plan for me Lord, because they are the best. I choose this day to praise you in all things and for all things, knowing that you are the author and finisher of my faith. All this I do in the mighty name and by authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, Amen.
