Topic: "The New Creation"

The Creation" focuses on God's original design and purpose for the world and for human life, and how that connects to living by the Spirit. To live in the Spirit, we must first understand why we were created and what God originally intended for human life. God intentionally created everything, and creation reflects His character, order, and goodness. Humans are created in God's image, meant to live in relationship with Him and to responsibly care for creation. What life looked like before sin: harmony with God, others, and nature. Understanding creation helps explain why dependence on the Spirit is necessary after the fall; the Spirit works to restore what was broken.
